

**HONORS CREDIT FOR REGULAR COURSES
PSYCHOLOGY DEPARTMENT**

Honors credit in a regular course is earned by doing substantial supplementary work (above and beyond the standard course requirements) that the instructor approves upon completion, in an introductory or advanced undergraduate course. Students interested in honors credit must arrange with an instructor (preferably within the first month of the semester) to do an honors project in that course, the terms and scope of which must be mutually agreed upon by the instructor and student before project initiation. Honors credit will be allowed when the final grade in the course is A+, A, A-, B+, B, or P.

MUTUAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN INSTRUCTOR AND STUDENT: If an instructor agrees to an honors project, the student and instructor *together* discuss thoroughly the nature of work to be done, including a tentative honors project title, scope of project, and due date. Ultimately, determination of whether the completed honors project warrants honors credit is at the instructor's discretion. If honors credit is earned, the instructor submits a request to the College to add the "Honors" grade notation to the student transcript in the form of an official transcript note.
